

What is Chronic Care Management (CCM)?

- CCM is a Medicare program designed for Medicare beneficiaries (patients) who have been diagnosed with two or chronic diseases, e.g. high blood press and arthritis.
- The primary focus of CCM is to offer patient-specific support through a quality-driven healthcare approach to patients with two or more chronic conditions.
- CCM is the building and maintaining of a patient-specific, comprehensive, care plan or Patient Health Summary.
- CCM is 24/7 access to a nurse for any enrolled patient anytime, anywhere.
- Participation in CCM may require a co-pay from you, depending on your insurance.

- A team of medical professionals available to enrolled patients: 24-hours a day, seven days a week, including weekends, and holidays.
